This month's image was taken on our recent summer trip to the White Mountains in New Hampshire. We were riding along Rt. 302 when we came to this nice field of wildflowers. Of course, I jumped out and worked my way across the field (you couldn't imagine how many sticker bushes there are in these fields) to get in close to the flowers. I didn't realize it, but Chris took this image as I was "outstanding in my field". The White Birch trees are beautiful when we head north. This was a nice spot.

What you can not see from this distance is the detail of the beautiful array of wildflowers. There were many yellow Black-Eye-Susans. There were also a nice variety with brown and maroon color variations, which I had never seen before. And there were a few pink Cone flowers mixed in to add a contrast. In the foreground are some kind of grey seed pods, which made a nice dramatic image we offer at shows.

But the most dramatic item that is not visible is the mountains. The best image of the trip was a scene which shows the varied Black-Eyed Susans with a single Cone flower in the foreground and the mountains in the distant background.
